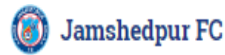

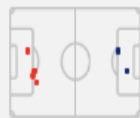

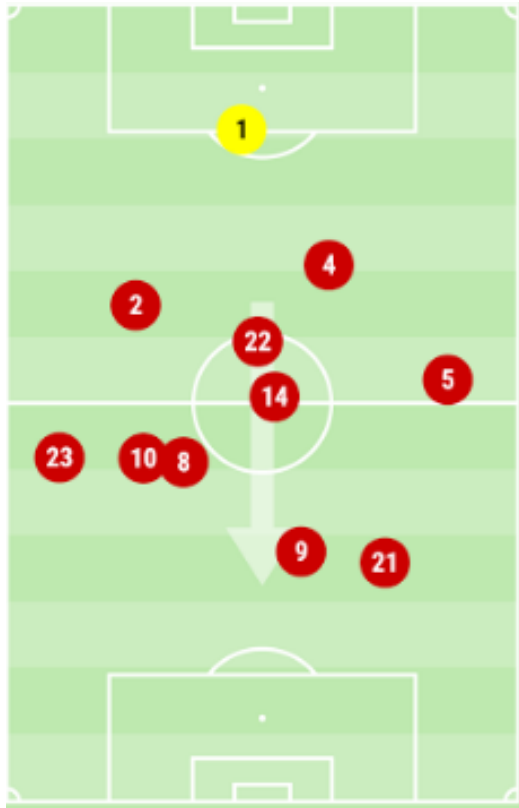

Observations

JFC:

- JFC managed to have 43% possession with 341 passes and 66% accuracy.
- They were more direct and dynamic in the attacks earlier in the first half and were threatening with penetrations, crosses and shots inside the box.
- They showed nice character in the early stages of the game winning duels at the back, transitioning quickly from defence to attack and also counter pressing (Ball oriented) when they lost possession.
- They also were very good defensively and their defensive were initially looked more position oriented zonal system and then shifts to a Man oriented zonal system as the opposition moves deep in the the half with possession.
- JFC were quick to move the line up when the ball is in the opposite half to help the team.
- The pressed for the ball and were a bit unorganized and let holes and pockets for Mihelic to occupy.
- JFC were more aggressive and attacking challenges came from the midfield mostly.
- They often put in numbers behind the ball and defended with 4-5-1 when positional defence and when pressing they played 4-4-2 or shifted to 4-3-3 where Mehtab would join the press up front.
- Their attacks where predominantly dependant on the long balls towards the attackers mostly towards their forwards where he had to lay it off for the other rushing attackers or help with short combination passes at the back to release the third man in the wings.
- So JFC had initially tried to overload the right flank or exploit the space behind jerry with the RM staying deeper and when they win the ball, the ball goes straight into the right flank which is being chased by Trindade.
- They were often numerically less in the Midfield which made them lose the midfield battle to the opposition.
- JFC's attack were not changing much except Belfort's movement in the left flank and Bikash dropping in, Jerry played a lot inside in the first half and allowed Shouvik Chakraborty to overlap, to provide crosses.
- JFC later after making the changes had shifted to a 4-3-3 where Trindade drops in as Holding Midfielder, Jerry and Izu playing the Central Attacking roles, Bikash and Doutie occupying the wings and Farukh playing the lone forward.
- JFC where not very threatening in the second half and where more defending and poor attacking in the counters.
- JFC managed to have 8 shots out of which only 2 were on target.

CFC:

- CFC played more of a possession game and dominated possession with an advantage of 57%. They managed this with 356 passes and 76% accuracy.
- They were defending wide and not compact horizontally, they defended compact vertically with Dhanpal always staying close to the defence line. Their Vertical lines were particularly were close in the first half with Nelson and Francis joining Dhanpal in the middle and overloading the central corridor at times and also helping to overload and give local compactness in the flanks to prevent crosses and but numerically more numbers to prevent crosses.
- CFC defensive shape 4-3-1-2 and when pressing they move into a 4-4-2.
- The team follows more of Position oriented Zonal system and switches to space

oriented zonal system when the opposition moves inside their half.

- Germanpreet Singh and Mihelic had more of free roles, Mihelic often adapted to shadow and screen passes and Germanpreet was more man oriented and attacked players and closed down spaces to put the opposition under pressure.
- Jeje helped the team's defence with press and also applied backward press in the game.
- CFC had strong and good defenders who are good in the air and can win Ariel battles. Dhanpal would often play more of a Libero and move back to reach Ariel balls.
- Dhanpal and the wingers also helped prevent overloads by local compactness in the wings preventing the Cb's to stay in position.
- CFC's attack were more possession based and tried to overload the flanks with the help of two mobile midfielders Mihelic and Germanpreet, They often formed boxes or combination of triangles with the wingers and the full backs to overload and help combination passes and maintain possession.
- CFC had the ball shifted wide and flank to flank to evade pressing and bring JFC's momentum down.
- CFC's attack had transitions from the fullbacks and through long balls from CB's or goalkeeper. The fullbacks helped move the attacks in the opposite third by vertical combinations with the winger and the midfielders.
- CFC managed to have 7 shots and just 1 on target. They were not very creative today and had just 4 key passes in the game. They managed to score the goal from the penalty spot.
- CFC had managed to win 67 duels and 27 Ariel duels when compared to 62 and 19 of the opposition. They didn't have much Set piece routines this game where their strength lie.
- Their main reason for today's win is the Mobile midfield combination of Germanpreet and Mihelic who managed to have 108 passes between them, their heat maps shows below how they manage to cover the horizontal length of the midfield and help with the team's attacks.





Subrata Pal (1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• He was not tested much with the shots in open play much and had just one penalty opportunity to test him in this match.• The penalty was also misjudged by him and Jeje sends him the wrong way with a calm and cool finish.• Subrata also stayed back and never moved out to make attempts to clear and had so much confidence in his defence.
Souvik Chakraborty (23)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• He was very attacking from the beginning of the game and had a lot of touches in the opposition half.• He often overlapped and had really good attacking opportunities in the final third.• He was a threat with his ability to whip balls into the box and often Nelson had to drop in to track him. He had 6 attempted crosses out of which a cross towards jerry into the 6 yard box with a curling effort is a notable one.• He was also quick to drop back and recover in the early stages of the game but later in the final quarter of the game was punished for moving up.  <ul style="list-style-type: none">•

<p>Andre Bikey (2)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He is very strong and Athletic. • He had a good first half winning almost all of the Ariel duels towards Nelson or Jeje and also committed himself to cover the Rb and stop the attacks from spaces behind. • He won 11/13 duels involved. • He likes to dribble the ball upfront when he finds space and had a notable dribble into centre of the opposition half pulling in the CB's and the Midfield line to put in a Diagonal ball to the attacking LB. • He was more of a Box to Box CB. • But whenever he moves out his void left is not well covered. • He had 25 passes in the game and 10 attempted long balls. • He was very crucial with the transition or in the build up from defence to attack. <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •
<p>Tiri (4)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He had a very defensive display and he was more of a ball playing CB with his long balls and short passes. • He was not involved in much of the duels except some of his where he had to stay with Jeje. • Mostly he stayed compact and tight with Bikey and his teammates.

<p>Mehtab Hossain (14)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He was very aggressive and had a yellow card trying to contain Mihelic. • He was the reason why the team conceded the penalty which was converted by Jeje. • He helped the attacks with his lateral movement and often dropped behind Jerry in the first half to overload the Right flank and also help Shouvik overlap. He even had 1 cross inside from the left flank early in the game which was stopped even after the brilliant effort from Belfort. • He had a total of 5 fouls in the game, he was quick to press and close down players but is very poor to efficiently tackle. 										
<p>Memo (22)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He is more of 6 in the team and stays deep often. • His passes are mostly short but may be the Avg length may be high, but mostly on the ground and is very efficient in finding the attackers from their own half. • He had a total 40 passes in the game. • His movements are mostly lateral and have a good distribution to the wingers. • He wins a lot of duels a won 11/18 duels. • He moved into the RCB role after Bikey was taken off from the game , even then he had a good game and was proving good with his passes behind the attackers and the midfield line. 										

Jerry (10)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He was very attacking in the initial 20 minutes of the game and was not much seen later. • He is usually very mobile and has good close control to dribble past the opponents and put in crosses. • Today he often was confronted by Jerry and was not able to get past him leading to shouvik moving out and putting in a 2v1 situation in the right flank. • He just had 2 crosses and 1 successful dribble in the game. • But today he was very good contributing to the press with his pace. • He had 1 good chance where he placed himself in the near post inside the six yard box but scrambled the cross.
Bikash Jairu (21)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He stayed a lot wide and high. • He didn't have many attempts with the ball to exploit. • He was losing a lot balls to Inigo and was often left stranded with 3 CFC players surrounding him. • He was initially winning the Ariel duels with Inigo but later on was not very successful both on ground and air.
Trindade (8)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He played the No.10 role initially. • Twice he made a diagonal run into the right channel in the counter attacks to exploit the space behind the Lb and was successful to put in cross (2) in the first 20 minutes. • Later he tried help overloads in the right flank but was not successful in turning them into useful attacks and losing possession. • He then played the 6 role in the last quarter of the game. But was often lured away from his position which let a huge gap between the midfield and defence with no one being the link.
Kervens Belford (9)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He played a lot direct in the first half and later started to Castle roles with Bikash to move into the left flank, He was not moving as often as he does towards the flanks. • Later he started to drop deep in an attempt to pull their CB's and open up spaces , He was successful to lay the ball off or develop attacks with short passes or One twos but those were not very successful to penetrate the opposition. • He had 2 good attempts in the first half which was saved by the keeper, one notable one was a cross from Mehtab which was scrambled by Bikash and dropped in Belford's feet inside the box where his turn and shot with his right foot in the near post sends Mailson clueless but was saved brilliantly by Karanjit. • He even had missed the opportunity to equalize from the penalty spot.
Substitutes:	

Farukh(17)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He came on to play just behind Belfort in the CF role and was not very effective and was not very mobile horizontally either to support attacks, later he moved into the ST role where his movements somewhat caused a disorganization in the CFC team and was threatening them. • He just had 5 passes in the game and was not seen much with the ball, but his off the ball movements helped JFC attack as CFC had to drop deeper.
Doutie(7)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He came on played in the right flank, helped the team with some of his defensive contributions to stop counter attacks develop, But was not good enough with his contribution in the offense. • He was very poor today with his dead ball contribution and sends rockets from set piece attempts.
IzuAzuka (25)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He played the Attacking mid role or kind of more a RF. • He was also not much of a help with his attacking role, but stayed up usually and was winning Air balls put towards him, but the duels were not converted into useful attacks. • He had 5 passes in the game.

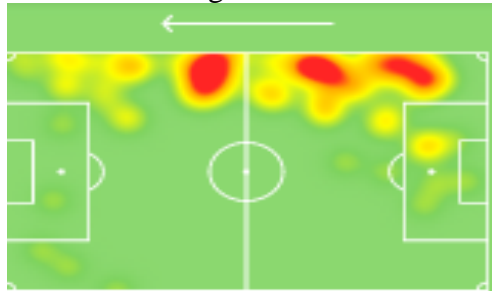
CFC:

- He had a very good game today, He was more successful defensively and was winning a lot of duels with the help of Dhanpal and Francis.



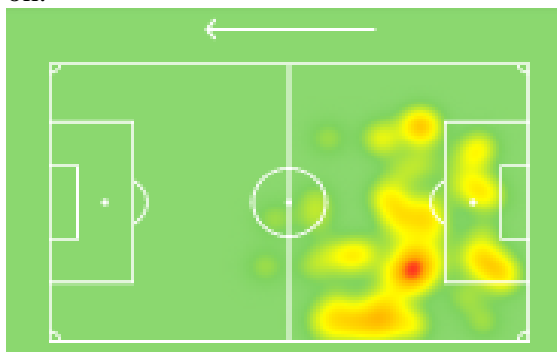

- He had been booked this game in an attempt to stop Belfort from attacking in the counter, He was very aggressive today and though he was involved in the penalty incident it was the slightest of touches and Bikash's reactions won the referee's call.
- He was very good in defending Set pieces in this game.
