### **Player Overview**

Bronte Fitzsimmons is a dynamic and hard-working attacking midfielder/forward currently playing in League 1 BC for Nanaimo United. Observed over three matches, she consistently demonstrates strong acceleration, tactical pressing, and a relentless work rate. Bronte is highly active both offensively and defensively, often contributing to her team's transitional play through pressing, ball recovery, and forward movement.

She uses her pace to beat defenders and draw fouls in dangerous areas. Her pressing ability and stamina enable her to recover possession in key moments and help transition her team into attack. Bronte is composed in 1v1 situations and has strong attacking instincts, particularly when making runs or positioning herself in the final third.

Areas for development include decision-making in the final third and consistency with passing accuracy. With focused attention on these, she has the potential to elevate her game to a higher level.

- **88'** Great defensive recovery; tracked back with pace and stopped a goal-scoring chance.
- 90' Delivered a quality corner that led to a penalty and a game-tying goal.

- 47' Rushed a cross; could have taken a touch and delivered a better ball.
- 48' Intelligent run into the box to create space for a teammate.
- 63' Imprecise pass under no pressure; decision-making and execution need work.
- **64'** Brilliant dummy move to fool defender and assist a goal; showed strong attacking IQ.

## Game 3 – vs Kamloops United

- **61'** Attempted a creative pass into the box; execution fell short, but vision was promising.
- 90' Made a well-timed run, beat the keeper with a touch, and calmly finished to win the game.
